**ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE = \$312,000**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Board of the West County Wastewater District ("West County Wastewater"), Richmond, California, invites and will receive sealed bids for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials and services specified for the construction of West County Wastewater Project No. 21LS401, Lakeside Force Main Replacement in conformance with the approved Contract Documents.

The work covered by this contract will be performed at one location along Hilltop Mall Road in the City of Richmond, CA 94806. The work includes, but is not limited to, the following:

1. HDD installation of 2 parallel 10-inch PE4710 DR11 FM (at 360 LF each).
2. Open trench installation of 2 parallel 10-inch PE4710 DR11 FM (at 1,240 LF each).
3. Providing all necessary materials, supplies, equipment, services and personnel, to adequately carry out or complete the project.
4. Performing work site cleanup duties, including, but not limited to removing all debris and placing materials, supplies and equipment in an organized manner, prior to leaving the site, each day.
5. All other work as shown and specified in the Contract Documents.

A pre-bid conference to discuss the project will be held at **02:00 P.M., local time on Wednesday April 7** at the discharge manhole at the Hilltop Mall, 2200 Hilltop Mall Road, Richmond, CA 94806. A non-mandatory site visit to be held immediately after the pre-bid conference shall be available for contractors interested in bidding the project.

Bid opening date: West County Wastewater will receive sealed bids at the reception area prior to **02:00 P.M., local time, Tuesday April 20** at 2910 Hilltop Drive, Richmond, CA 94806. At the deadline, accepted bids will be publicly opened.

Contract Documents are on file and may be examined without charge at the West County Wastewater Administrative Offices, 2910 Hilltop Drive, Richmond, CA 94806.

Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained at the West County Wastewater Administrative Offices. The Contract Documents may be obtained for a nonrefundable fee of \$50.00 if picked up, or \$60.00 if requested by mail. Payment must be made at the time that the

documents are obtained. Make check and/or money order payable to West County Wastewater. Credit cards are also accepted.

**In accordance with SB 854, all participating contractors and subcontractors must be registered with the Public Works Contractor Registration program established by the Department of Industrial Relations.**

Attention is directed to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements for bidders as detailed in Section 00 45 27. "Contractors are required to post subcontractor solicitations for a minimum of thirty (30) calendar days before the bid opening date."

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Part 7, Chapter 1, Article 2, and Section 1770 et. seq. of the Labor Code of the State of California, the successful bidding contractor and its subcontractors shall pay their labor forces not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of Industrial Relations, and travel and subsistence pay as such are defined in applicable collective bargaining agreements filed in accordance with Sections 1773.1 and 1773.8 of said Labor Code, for work needed and performed on this Project. Said determinations, in effect at the time of publishing this notice, are on file at the above identified West County Wastewater Administrative Offices and may be examined there, and copies of which are available to any interested party on request. It shall, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1773.2 of said Labor Code, be a requirement of the work for the successful bidding contractor to post and maintain a copy of said wages' determination at the project sited throughout the duration of the work.

Bids to receive consideration must be signed by the bonafide prime contractor who proposes to undertake the work and who is properly licensed in accordance with the Contractor's License Law as provided beginning at Section 7000 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California. The valid license(s) required for the work as follows: **Class A (General Engineering Contractor), Class C-34 (Pipeline Contractor) or Class C-42 (Sanitation System Contractor)**. Each bid submitted must be on the forms furnished within the Project Contract and must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bidder's bond for an amount not less than ten percent of the aggregate total bid.

The Contractor shall be allowed to substitute securities for any funds withheld to ensure performance under this Contract pursuant to Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code.

West County Wastewater's Board of Directors reserves the right to reject any or all bids for the work and waive any irregularity in bids received. Dated at Richmond, California, this 2nd day of April, 2021.
