RECOGNIZES HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH SEPTEMBER 15 - OCTOBER 15, 2021 “ESPERANZA: A CELEBRATION OF HISPANIC HERITAGE AND HOPE”

WHEREAS, from September 15th to October 15th every year in the United States, we honor the contributions of Latino and Hispanic communities with the celebration of National Hispanic Heritage Month while highlighting their diversity, culture and traditions.

WHEREAS, this year’s theme is “Esperanza: A Celebration of Hispanic Heritage and Hope”; and

WHEREAS, National Hispanic Heritage Month had its origins when the U.S. Congress passed Public Law 90-498 on September 17, 1968, which authorized and requested the President of the United States to issue an annual proclamation designating the week, including September 15th and 16th, as National Hispanic Heritage Week; and

WHEREAS, in 1988 the U.S. Congress passed Public Law 100-401, which amended Public Law 90-498 and established National Hispanic Heritage Month, and the U.S. President was again authorized and requested to issue an annual proclamation designating the “31-day period beginning September 15th and ending on October 15th as National Hispanic Heritage Month; and

WHEREAS, the fabric of our nation is richer and stronger due to the significant influence and contributions of inspirational Latino and Hispanic American leaders, sports legends, actors and actresses, singers and musicians, amongst many others,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Directors of the West County Wastewater District hereby proclaim recognition of Hispanic Heritage Month, September 15th through October 15th, 2021 commemorating this year’s theme of “Esperanza: A Celebration of Hispanic Heritage and Hope”, and encourages all community members and employees to join in embracing the diversity, culture, and traditions that Latino and Hispanic people have contributed to society.




